## ANDRÉ BOULANGER

### CEO BNP PARIBAS THE NETHERLANDS

#### EDUCATION AND EARLY CAREER

André Boulanger (1963) was born in Belgium and graduated in 1986 from Université Libre de Bruxelles. After graduating, André Boulanger joined Crédit Communal de Belgique (Dexia) and worked there until joining Banque Paribas Belgium in 1989 to become the Managing Director of the Brussels Office.

#### CAREER AT THE BANK

After working as Managing Director of the Brussels Office of Banque Paribas Belgium for nearly five years André Boulanger became Deputy Director for Risks for the Belgian subsidiary of Banque Paribas Belgium. The following year, in 1994, he moved to Banque Paribas France where he was Deputy Director of the European subsidiaries charged with the coordination of these subsidiaries. He moved back to Belgium in 1998 to become General Manager of the Belgian branch. In 2000 he became General Manager of the Belgium branch of BNP Paribas after the merger of BNP and Paribas. André Boulanger returned to France in 2002 to work for BNP Paribas's Corporate & Investment Banking (CIB) and Structured Finance divisions as Director of the region Continental Europe. In 2006 he became Director Central and Eastern Europe for CIB's Coverage Clients. Here he also served as Member of the Global Management Committee for Coverage Clients. In 2007 André Boulanger returned to Belgium as CEO of BNP Paribas Belgium and subsequently moved back to BNP Paribas France in 2008 as Director of the Corporate & Transaction Group and Member of the Management Committee for the Corporate & Investment Bank.

In 2010 André Boulanger was appointed as CEO and Chief Country Officer of BNP Paribas Netherlands. Since 2008 the BNP Paribas Group in The Netherlands has grown significantly. Insinger de Beaufort Wealth Management and former Fortis activities, now BNP Paribas Investment Partners and BNP Paribas Leasing Solutions, joined the group. In 2010 André Boulanger expanded the Corporate and Investment Banking business in the Netherlands with the opening of four Business Centres; in Amsterdam, Rotterdam, Utrecht and Eindhoven. BNP Paribas's CIB business in The Netherlands is partner of more than 80% of the Dutch AEX listed companies and has an increasing client base. BNP Paribas The Netherlands has leadership positions in businesses that span CIB, securities services, asset management, insurance, private banking, leasing and consumer finance.
